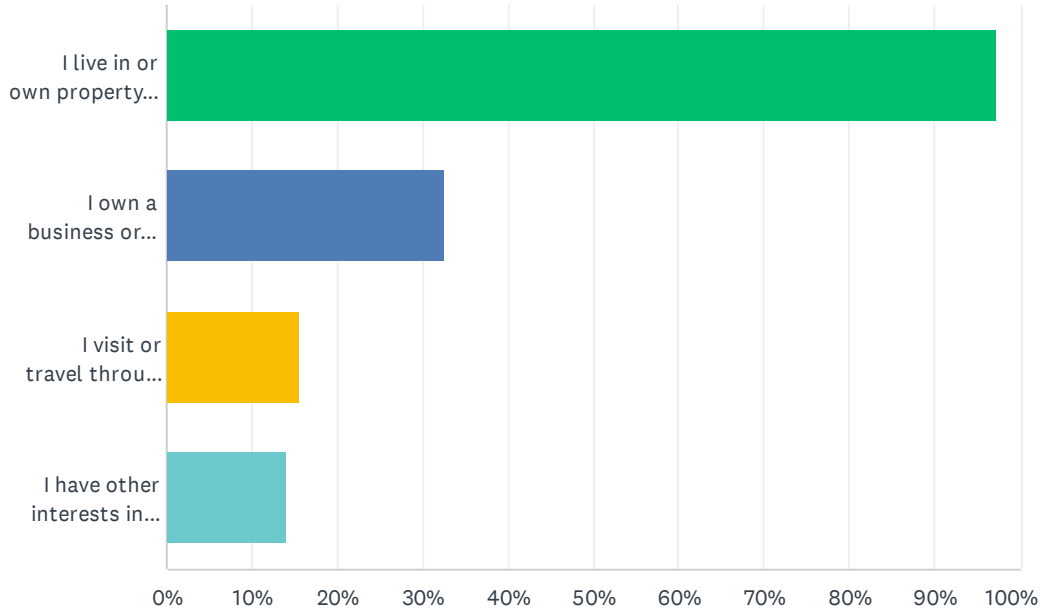


Q1 Do you live, own property, own a business, work or regularly visit Pitt County? (please choose all that apply).

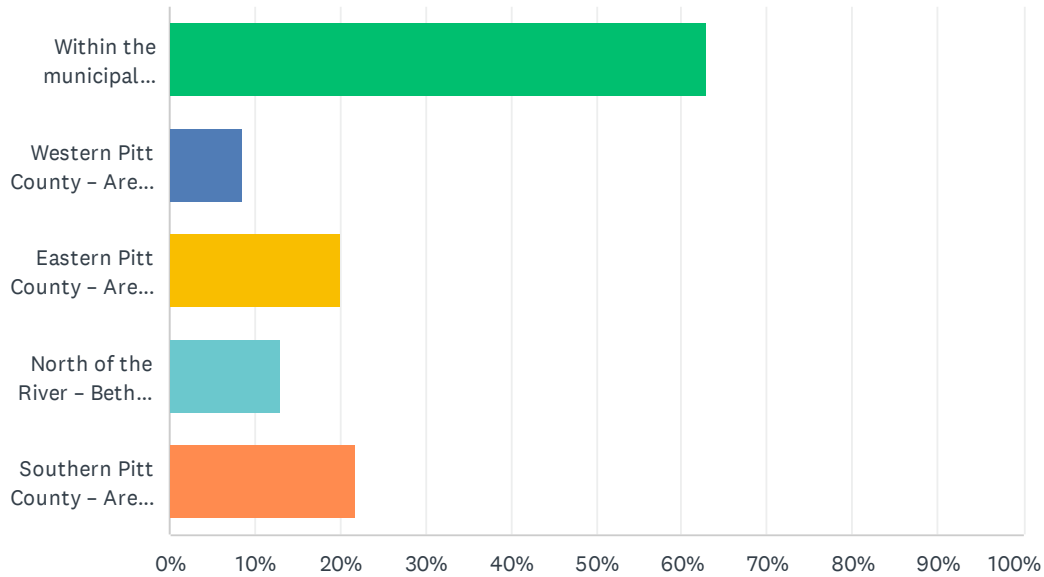

Q2 What part of Pitt County do you spend the most time in (i.e. live, work or own property)?

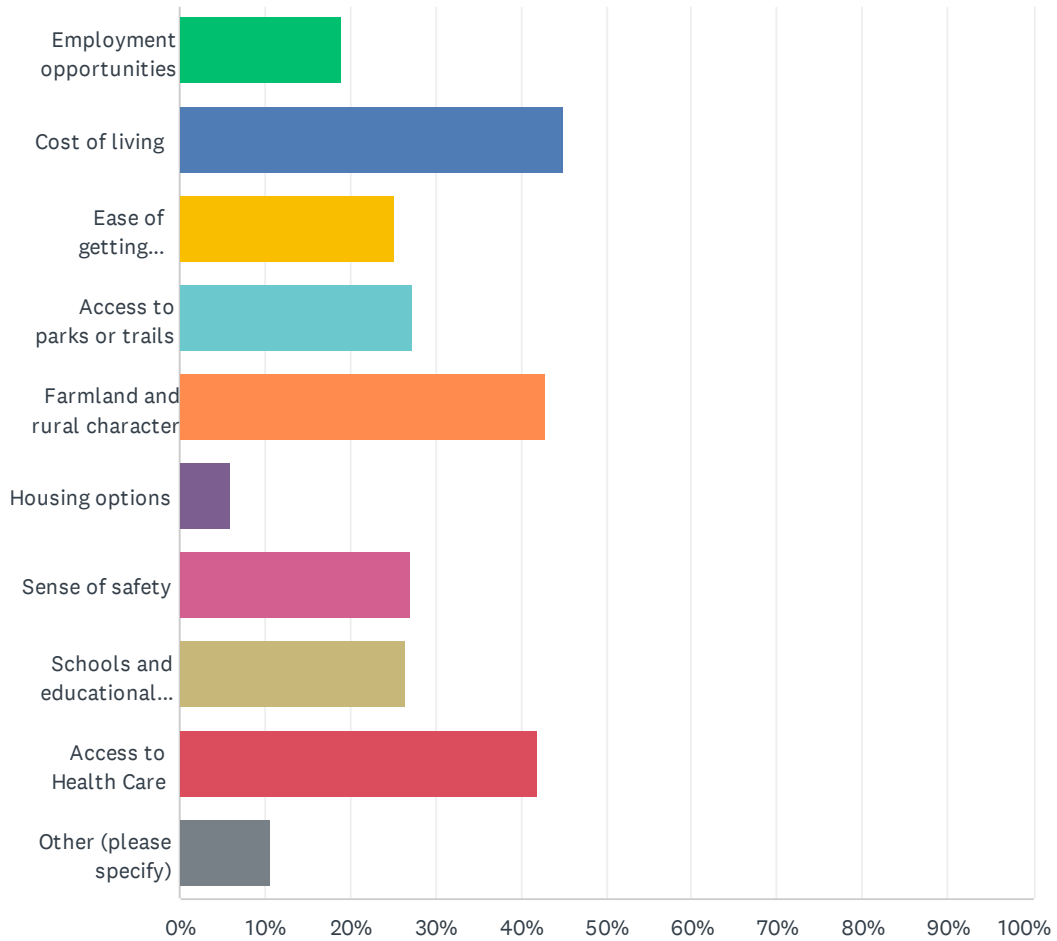

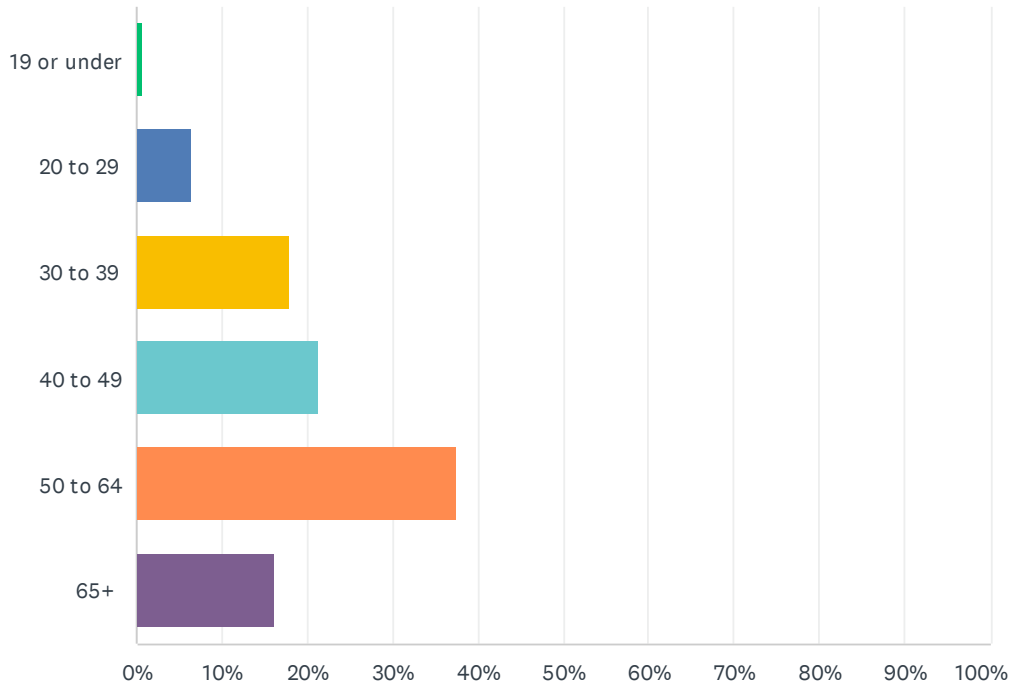

Q14 What is your age?

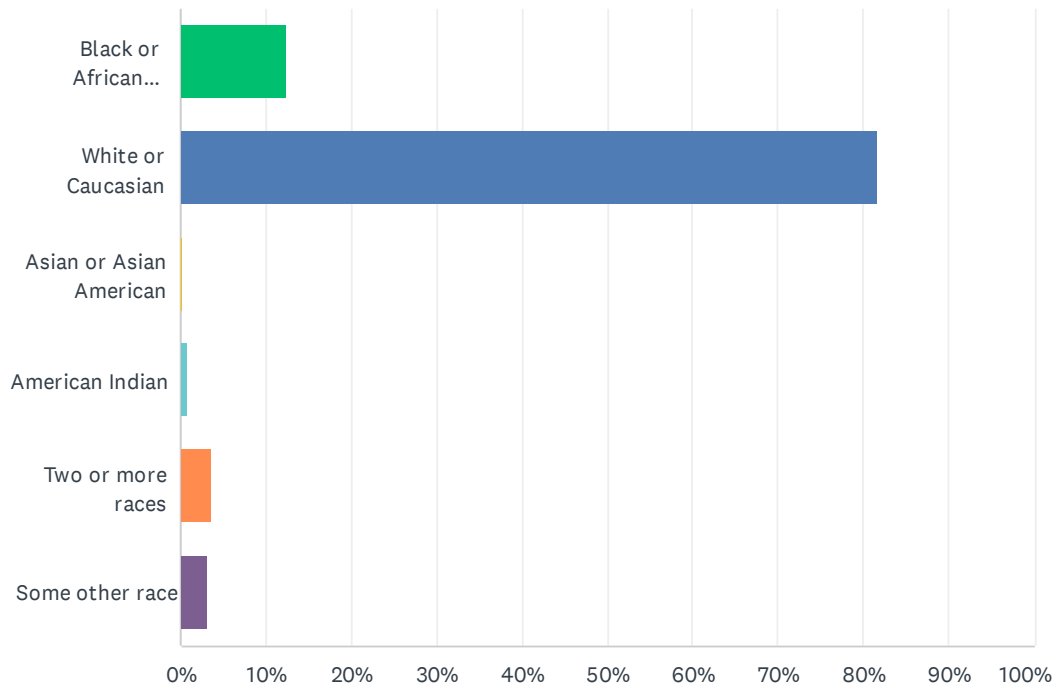

Q15 What best describes your race? (Select all that apply)

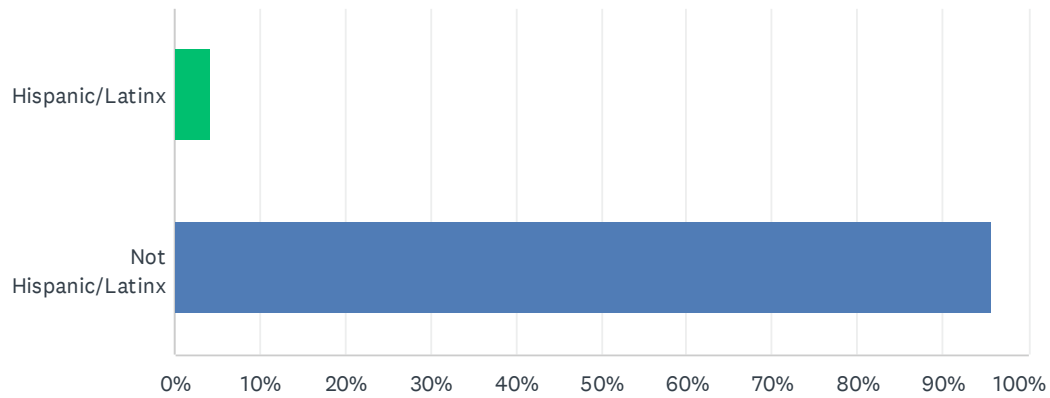

Q16 What is your ethnicity?

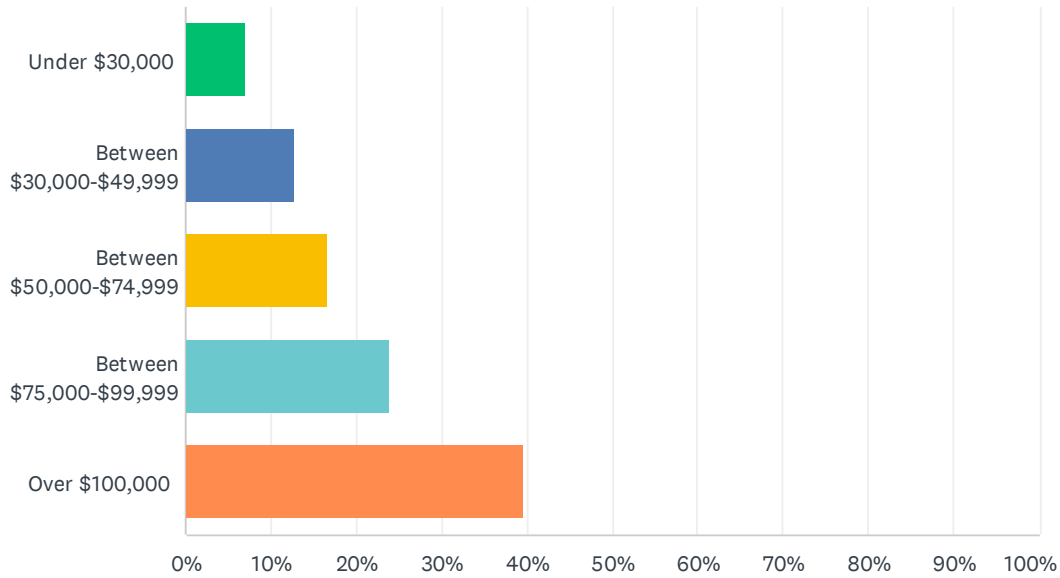
